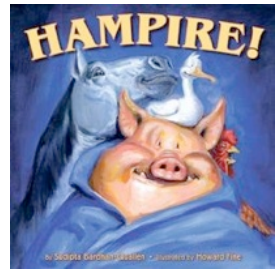

Ballots for Belva: A biography of Belva Lockwood, a lawyer and suffragette, who ran for president in 1884 despite the fact that women weren't allowed to vote. Young readers will cheer Belva’s can-do spirit while being astounded by the obstacles in her path. Ages 4 - 8.

Chicks Run Wild: When Mama Hen kisses her kids goodnight, she expects them to stay in bed. But those chicks...run...wild! Mama gets her chickies settled—but it turns out she’s not ready for bed, either. Ages 2 - 6.

Flying Eagle: Father eagle must feed his baby. As father soars across the African sky, readers will see beautiful illustrated pictures of the gorgeous sunset, hippos, crocodiles, lions, zebras, and even a cobra! Information about the majestic eagle is included in the back of the book, as are details about the Serengeti National Park in Africa, and other resources. Ages 5 - 10.

Half-Pint Pete the Pirate: Half-Pint Pete the Pirate sailed half the seven seas, but with only half of a treasure map, he's never found what he's looking for. Until the day he meets Belle—a pirate with half a map of her own. Ages 3 - 6.

Hampire: Duck cannot sleep because he is hungry, but while he is preparing a snack the Hampire, who roams the barnyard at night sinking his fangs into food, is creeping near. Will Duck—and his snacks—make it safely back to bed? Ages 4 - 8.

The Hog Prince: On the advice of a mixed-up fairy, Eldon the hog tries to achieve his princely ambitions by kissing the perfect mate. Eldon smooches anyone in sight--but what if true love has been waiting under his snout all along? Ages 3 - 6.

Kitchen Science Experiments: The kitchen is a perfect place for budding mad scientists to experiment; introduces basic chemistry concepts that can be learned in everyday kitchens; with easy-to-follow instructions and scientific explanations for each experiment. Ages 9 -12.

Nature Science Experiments: Fun, easy-to-use, and accessible, this cool collection of science activities will have kids eagerly carrying out experiments with common, everyday objects from the home and backyard. Ages 9 - 12.

Quackenstein Hatches a Family: A lonely duck at the zoo adopts an egg, but when it hatches he is shocked by what emerges. Quallen’s clever rhyming text is perfectly paired with cute and spooky art from Brian T. Jones. Ages 5 - 8. Note: This book references adoption.
